The Design Schools Workshop is a collaborative workshop involving mixed (École Nationale Supérieure Des Arts Décoratifs De Paris / Pratt Institute) teams of students.









## Invisible handicap

French and American schools will participate online synchronously over 7 days, in seven teams of three selected students. The final public presentation to the jury shall be held online on Wednesday 2nd, 2021, 12:00 pm EST.

#### SELECTED TOPIC

Care design or how to make handicap invisible What is handicap? What could *invisible handicap* mean?

Through meetings and exchanges with doctors, patient associations, a psychologist and a philosopher, we will question the meaning of handicap and the various situations that may be experienced by handicapped patients, their families and their caregivers in order to imagine innovative and sensitive devices designed to care. By focusing your research (monitored by design professors and PhD students) on a specific challenge and adopting a particular point of view (from the patient's perspective, the members of his/her family, caregivers' ones or), you will design objects, images, services to help patients, raise common awareness and encourage support.

Your tools will be the drawing, 3D modeling and a paper model (to represent your project).

This project will be presented to a jury of recognized professionals.
